Mission Statement

Dedicated to improving the lives of children with physical disabilities and their families

Accomplishments

• 86% of funding spent on Programs

- Held 3 Fundraising Events, as well as an Exclusive Dinner at Charley's Steak House
- We had 39 pieces of media coverage

Accomplishments Summary

We are proud to report that Wheelchairs 4 Kids had a successful 15th year. We continue to spend the majority of our funds on programs (**86%**), followed by fundraising (**8%**), and finally administration (**6%**). It is very important to us that our supporters are confident that their donations are being used wisely.

This fiscal year, we provided medical equipment or home/vehicle modifications to **378** children, a **16%** increase over last fiscal year.

Wheelchairs 4 Kids expanded our Wheely Fun Days inclusion program, and held **23** events for our families with over **1,800** total participants. Our Wheely Fun Days included: Tampa Bay Buccaneers Training Camp, adaptive surfing, the classic Wheely Wonderful Christmas Party, adaptive water-skiing, an accessible prom live WWE events, and many more!

This year, we returned to Morgan's Camp in Texas and Camp Twin Lakes in Georgia where a total of 59 families joined us for sleep-away summer camp. At our Camps, Wheel Kids and their families participated in rock climbing, zip-lining, ropes courses, and other iconic camp activities!

Wheelchairs 4 Kids was also excited to return to Breckenridge, Colorado, with **20** of our Florida

Wheel Kids for adaptive downhill skiing.

This fiscal year, we **added two new programs**. Our **Scholarship Program** awarded seven Wheel Kids with tuition assistance as they pursue college or vocational school. We also assisted three families through our **Compassion Program**, which provides up to \$1,000 toward funeral costs.

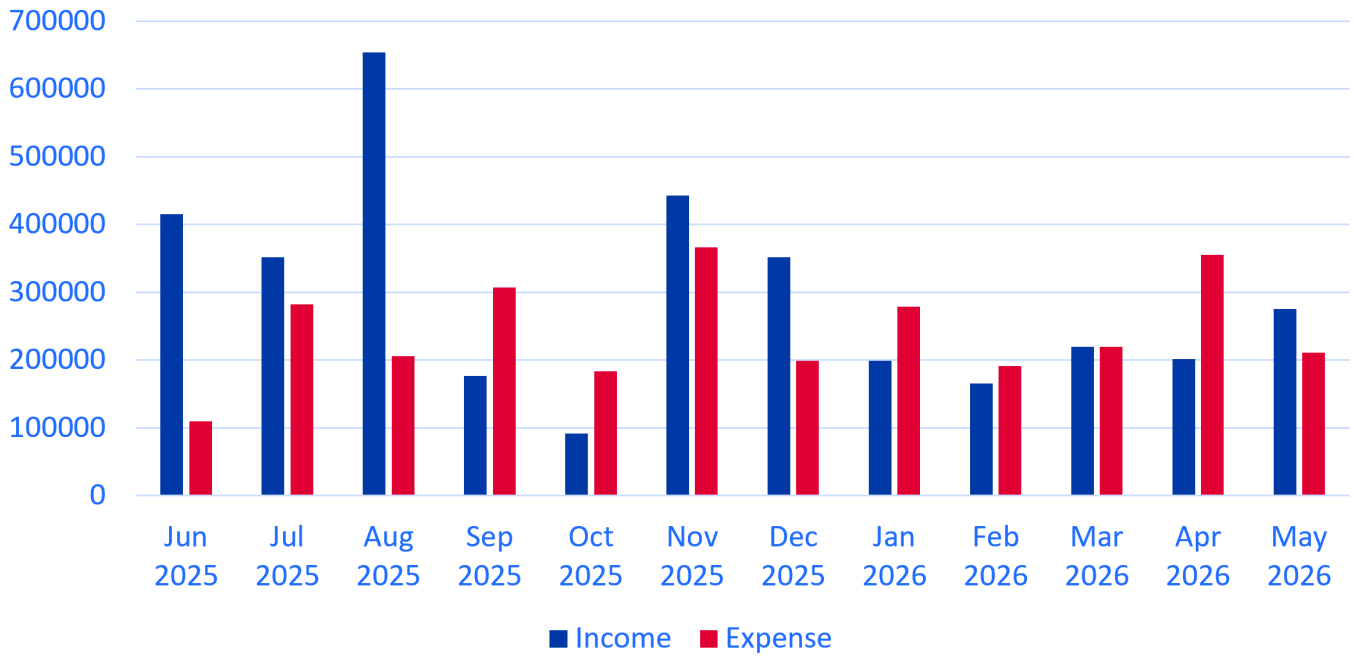
We hosted three successful signature fundraisers. Our fiscal year kicked off with a bang in July at Eddie V's Prime Seafood with our Jail & Bail, where we raised over **\$200,000**. In November, we returned to Ruth Eckerd Hall with our Wheely Good Time Live and Silent Auction. May brought us to Innisbrook Golf Resort for a record-breaking Celebrity Golf Tournament. This event featured a roster of professional athletes, including **Rob Gronkowski**.

Additionally, we were chosen by Talk of the Town Restaurant Group to be their benefiting charity for the month of January, which includes a round-up at each of their restaurants, as well as a private dinner with silent auction at Charley's Steak House in Tampa.

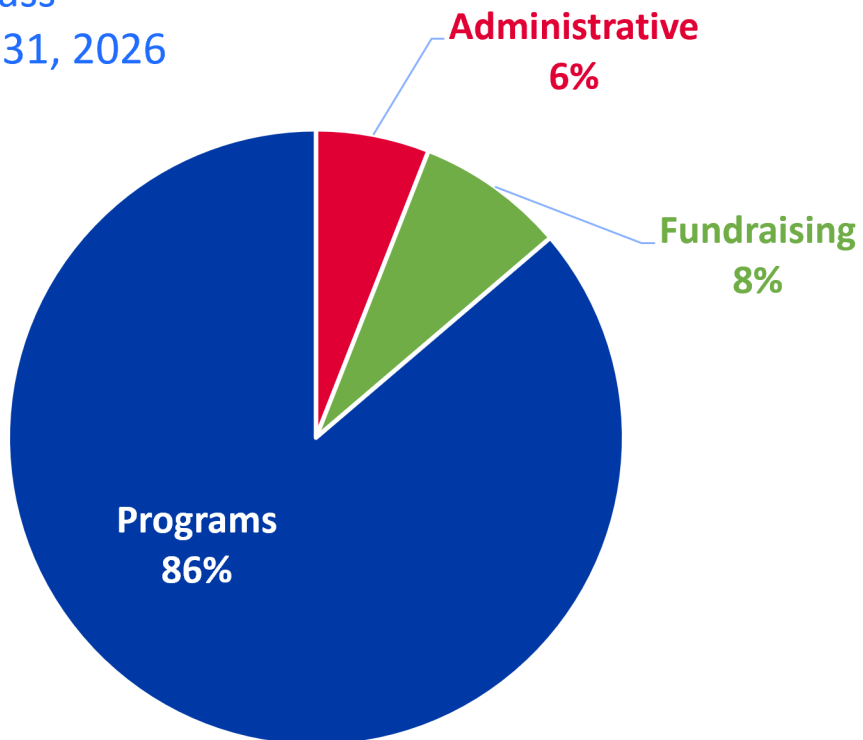
The most important statistic, however, is family satisfaction. We are thrilled to report a **100% family satisfaction rating**.

About our Programs

Let's Roll Mobility Equipment Program

Wheelchairs 4 Kids' primary goal is to give children with physical disabilities what they need to thrive at home and in their community.

Let's Roll addresses mobility and accessibility by providing wheelchairs, home and vehicle modifications, as well as necessary medical equipment that has been denied by insurance or Medicaid, or is otherwise out of financial reach.

Our Let's Roll Program also encompasses our Facility Program, which provides gently used equipment from our inventory to schools, clinics, and other facilities, in order to benefit multiple children in their care.



Wheelchairs 4 Kids is proud to have provided over 2300 wheelchairs, home and vehicle modifications, as well as other necessary medical equipment since our founding in 2011.

Wheely Fun Days Inclusion Program

Often, children with physical disabilities are left out by their peers due to their mobility and accessibility needs.

Wheely Fun Days addresses socialization and inclusion by hosting confidence- and community-building events.

These experiences give them memories that will last a lifetime, while making connections with each other, as well as their able-bodied peers.

Whether they are coming together for a day of adaptive sports, an inclusive party, or a weekend at accessible summer camp, the Wheel Kids leave with new friends knowing they can do anything!

Scholarship Program

Like most young adults, the teens we serve dream of freedom. For some, that means continued education.

People with disabilities often struggle to enter the workforce. We want to help these kids grow and develop the tools they need to get good jobs.

Our Scholarship Program addresses independence by awarding tuition assistance for young adults seeking higher education or vocational school.

Compassion Program

The unfortunate truth about working with children with physical disabilities is that they sometimes leave us too soon.

Our Compassion Program helps families experiencing their worst days by assisting with funeral costs. This allows families to navigate this difficult time by relieving some of their burden.
